01 | DACA IS VALID UNTIL EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION DOCUMENT (EAD) EXPIRATION DATE



02 | NEW DACA APPLICATIONS WILL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED



03 | PERMITS EXPIRING BETWEEN TODAY AND MARCH 5, 2018 MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR RENEWAL BY OCTOBER 5, 2017



04 | ADVANCE PAROLE TO TRAVEL ABROAD IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE TO DACA RECIPIENTS



05 | DECISION TO END DACA DOES NOT AFFECT IN-STATE TUITION OR SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AT THE U
